3.11 Recognition by the international R&D&I community

The main examples documenting the recognition of FA USB staff by the international scholarly community

Examples when the scholarship of FA USB staff was recognized by the international community (see tables 3.11.1, 3.11.2, 3.11.3 and 3.11.4) show that theoretical and methodological insights resonate in the international context. There were brought about by results of systematic and general research focused on the history of society in the Czech lands from the early 16th century to mid-20th century (with the emphasis on social and cultural history of aristocratic elite), by auxiliary historical sciences, history of administration, ego-documents or editions of historical resources; theory and history of Czech literature from the 19th century to the present, in its relation to literature in English, German and Romance languages or the methodology of literary history, including the issue of representation of artistic texts or relations to the neo-pragmatic thinking; archaeology of prehistory, Middle Ages and early modern times, as well as environmental archaeology; selected problems of Romance synchronous linguistics and the research into the language of science and the history of Romance literatures and their reception in the Czech lands. This is further documented by frequent participation of the staff on foreign scholarly symposiums, colloquiums, workshops, invited lectures, as well as by international publication activity, including a support by local and international grants.
